



DEFENSIVE AND COMPETITIVE BIDDING
OVERCALLS (Style; Responses; 1/2 Level; Reopening)
1-level may be weak, 2-level usually sound.
3-level CUE = support (usually 4-c), 8-10
2NT after overcall in M = support (usually 4-c), 11+
When 3 rd hand passes:
New suit F1, jump in new suit FG
When 3 rd hand bids:
New suit NF, fit-showing jumps, TRF after 1x (1M) DBL
1N OVERCALL (2 nd /4 th Live; Responses; Reopening)
15-18 (12-16). SYS-ON
JUMP OVERCALLS (Style; Responses; Unusual NT)
Weak (2NT response F1)
2NT 5-5 two lowest, sound (19-21 BAL when reopening)
DIRECT AND JUMP CUE-BIDS (Style; Responses; Reopen)
CUE in 2 nd hand = 5-5 two highest, sound. (2NT ART F1)
Jump CUE in 2 nd hand = 5-5 highest-lowest, sound
Other CUEs = 5-5 with highest + one
VS. NT (Vs. Strong/Weak; Reopening; Passed Hand)
2♣=2-suiter with 4+♥, second suit (any) often longer
2♦=2-suiter with 4+♠, second suit (any) often longer
DBL by passed hand = one minor.
VS. PREEMPTS (Doubles; Cue-bids; Jumps; NT Bids)
DBL T/O through 3♦
Vs 3M: DBL OPT, 4m = NAT with (3)4-c oM, CUE = oM + other
Vs 2M: CUE = oM + other
Vs 2m/3m: CUE = both Majors
Jump to 4m = two-suiter
VS. ARTIFICIAL STRONG OPENINGS
DBL = both Majors, at least 5-4
NT = both minors, at least 5-4
OVER OPPONENTS' TAKEOUT DOUBLE
TRF after 1♣ (DBL)
TRF after 1M (DBL) from 1NT to 2M-1

OTHER SIGNALS (INCLUDING TRUMPS)			
Hi-low=odd (original count)			
From a 5-c suit, we may encourage with 4th best if low enough to be clear.			
When discouraging from a 5+ suit:			
High odd may show interest in higher suit, high even in lower.			
DOUBLES			
TAKEOUT DOUBLES (Style; Responses; Reopening)			
11+, 3+M unless 17+. CUE = F to suit agreement			
(1♠)-DBL-(P)-1NT negative (0-6/7)			
Responsive DBL			
LEB variations			
SPECIAL, ARTIFICIAL AND COMPETITIVE DOUBLES/REDOUBLES			
1♣-(1♦)-DBL=4+♥; 1♣-(1♥)-DBL=4+♠; 1♣-(1♠)-DBL=TRF to 1NT;			
1♣-(DBL)-RDBL= both minors

Two-way 1♣: 11-13 BAL or 17+ any	
1♦ 11-16 4+, UNBAL (longer ♣ possible)	
1♥/♠ 11-16 5+	
2♦ 11-16, 3-suiter with short ♦ (4-4-1-4 or 4-4-0-5)	
1NT Openings: 14-16	
2-over-1 Responses: F1 (does not guarantee rebid)	
SPECIAL BIDS THAT MAY REQUIRE DEFENCE	
1♣ 11-13 BAL or 17+ any	
2♦ 11-16, 3-suiter with short ♦ (4-4-1-4 or 4-4-0-5)	
3NT PRE, broken minor (NAT 4m opening)	
4♣/♦ Strong 4M-opening	
SPECIAL FORCING PASS SEQUENCES	
IMPORTANT NOTES THAT DON'T FIT ELSEWHERE	
After 1NT (DBL = PEN):	
P PUP-RDBL, then 2♣=♣+M, 2♦=♦+♠, 2♥=♥+♠	
RDBL PUP-2♣ (any 5+ suit)	
2m 4-4 m + next higher	
Psychics: Rare (occasional weak 3 rd hand openings)
