## About HCL International Bridge Championship

Bridge is a strategy game that teaches one to be of a tougher mindset, to use one's intellect to maximum capacity, communicate powerfully and to pursue victory diligently. These are the qualities that makes bridge a perfect fit for HCL . HCL has been strongly supporting the game in India since 2003 through the HCL International Bridge Championship held every year in New Delhi, India. The Championship is the premier bridge tournament in the country and the biggest In terms of the prize money and participation levels. The 2019 Championship(17th edition) had a prize purse of Rs. 18 million and witnessed a record participation of nearly 1000 players from 185 Teams ( 55 in Gold, 102 in Silver \& 28 in Bronze). International teams having players from USA, Poland, Italy, Bulgaria, Russia, Netherlands, Israel, Sweden, Iceland, South Africa, UK, Australia, New Zealand, Croatia, Denmark, Romania, Japan, Thailand, Jordan, Sri Lanka \& Bangladesh have participated in the last few editions of the Championship.

As the 2020 championship couldn't take place due to the pandemic, HCL will now be hosting the 18th edition of HCL International Bridge Championship online on RealBridge / BridgeMagic (powered by HCL) platforms from September 18-26, 2021. The total prize money for the online event will be Rs. 2 Million (USD 27,000 ). The Championship will have three main events and a "Team of four Bronze" event for the newcomers. There will be an IMP Pairs event along with the main Match Point Pairs event.

- Team of Four Gold - Winners will be awarded the 'Naresh Tandan Trophy'
- Team of Four Sliver - Winners will be awarded the 'MohIni Tandan Trophy'
- Open Pairs - Winners will be awarded the 'Neena Bonarji Trophy'
- Team of Four Bronze - Winners will be awarded the "HCL Rising Stars Trophy".

## IMPORTANT NOTES FOR THE PARTICIPANTS

- All participating players should be registered under BFI Master Point Scheme, except the foreign players, who will be assigned a temporary Player ID for the event.
- IMPORTANT - This is a Ranking Point event and hence performance in the Gold Teams / Open MP Pairs will be eligible for Ranking Points for Indian Teams selection, as per the BFI Ranking Point Policy 2021.
- Participation in this tournament is open to all resident bridge players of Indian Nationality. Teams with one or more non-resident or OCI card holder Indian bridge player(s) or players of other NBO's of foreign nationality are also eligible to participate.
- However, the non-resident Indian / OCI Card holder Indian / foreign player(s) or an Indian resident player partnering a non-resident Indian / OCI card holder Indian/ foreign player will not be eligible for the ranking points from this tournament. In case, if the non-resident / OCl card holder / foreign player has played with 2 or more Indian partners in the team event, then all of them will be ineligible for the ranking points.
- In a ranking point Pairs event, an Indian resident player partnering a non-resident Indian / OCI card holder / foreign player will not be eligible for the Ranking points for the event. However, they will be eligible for the prize.
- Teams participating in "Team of Four" event in Gold / Silver categories can have a minimum of four and maximum of 8 players in the team.
- In Silver Team event, maximum two player in the team can be of the rank of National Masters (having minimum 500 Federation points) but below Life Master (i.e. below 1000 Federation points). They can play as team "Mentors" but both cannot play in a partnership. Rest of the players should be below the rank of National Master.
- By default a foreign team has to play in Gold category only. A foreign team or a foreign player(s) can participate in Silver Team event, only after getting clearance from the Technical Committee.
- For all team events, it is mandatory for each player to play a minimum $25 \%$ of the boards at each stage of the tournament. See SCoC for more details.
- There is no rank restriction for participation in Open MP / IMP Pairs.
- TRIOS are not allowed in any of the Pairs event.
- All the events will be played on RealBridge / BridgeMagic platform. For playing on RealBridge / BridgeMagic platform, players have to ensure that they have a laptop or PC with Camera \& Microphone facility and a good internet connection. This is a mandatory condition and players should ascertain that they are equipped with the required paraphernalia before entering the event. It may please be noted that you can't play the event on mobile phone.
- Teams participating in "Team of Four" event in Bronze categories can have a minimum of four and maximum of 6 players in the team. No foreign player(s) will be allowed to participate in Bronze event.
- In Bronze event, only two players having up to 100 Master points and rest of the players with up to 50 Master Points will be allowed. The Technical committee reserves the right to reject an entry, in case they feel that a player is not eligible to participate as per the conditions.
- The Bronze event will be played only if there are a minimum of 12 teams participating in the event. In case the number is less than 12, the participating teams of Bronze category will be merged with the Silver event and no separate prizes for the Bronze event will be given.
- The MPs to be considered for participation in the Silver \& Bronze events will be as on $15^{\text {th }}$ Sep 2021.
- Detailed information on the schedule \& SCoC will be circulated on the Tournament Web site www.hcl-bridge.com \& various Bridge related WhatsApp groups.
- All participating players should go through and abide by the tournament SCoC, which will be published on Tournament website www.hcl-bridge.com latest by $1^{\text {st }}$ Sep 2021.
- Entries for all events will start from 1st Sep 2021 on Tournament website www.hcl-bridge.com.
